## PROCEEDINGS.

By the Government Order read as seventh paper, the Government constituted a Pay Revision Committee to review the existing orders regarding the pay scales of both Gazetted and Non-Gazetted Officers in the Travancore-Cochin and Malabar areas and to suggest new unified scales with due regard to the financial-position of the State. The Government have now received the Report of the Committee. The Report is being published separately.

After carefully considering the recommendations of the -Gommittee, the Government are pleased to issue the following orders:—

#### A. REVISION OF PAY SCALES.

- 1. The scales of pay of the various posts—Gazetted and Non-Gazetted, will be revised as shown in Annexure I.
- 2. The orders issued in the Government Proceedings read as first, second and fourth papers above, are hereby cancelled.

- 3. The District Judges and the Additional District Judges, the Graduate Teachers and the Primary School Teachers, the Nursing Staff and the Work Establishment Staff whose pay scales have been recently revised are not included in this revision. Orders regarding Transport Department, pensionable posts in Government Commercial Concerns and technical posts in the Government Press will issue separately.
- 4. The revised scales of pay sanctioned for the Village Staff will apply for the present only to the Village Officers and Village Assistants in the Travancore-Cochin area. The question of extending the scales to those in the Malabar area will be considered after the village administration is reorganised and the conditions of service of the staff are brought on a par with those of their counterparts in Travancore-Cochin area.
- 5. The pay/salary of officers in the revised scales of pay will be fixed in the manner prescribed in Annexure II.

## B. RATIONALISATION OF ALLOWANCES.

## 1. Compensatory Allowance, Risk Allowance.

The rates of compensatory allowance and risk allowance now given in the Medical Department will be refixed as shown in Annexure III.

## 2. Mess and Dhoby Allowance to Nurses.

The rates of Mess and Dhoby Allowances drawn by the various categories of Nurses in the Malabar and Travancore-Cochin areas will be unified as follows:—

Mess Allowance .. Rs. 20 per mensem Dhoby Allowance .. Rs. 3 per mensem.

#### 3. Uniform Allowance to Nurses and Midwives.

The Uniform Allowance to Nurses and Midwives is fixed as below:

Nurses .. 20 yards of cloth and Rs. 25 per annum Midwives .. 10 yards of cloth and Rs. 5 per annum.

## 4. Allowances to non-clinical teaching staff, Medical College.

The allowance to the non-clinical teaching staff of the Medical College will be refixed as indicated in the Annexure IV.

## 5. Allowance to Fire Brigade staff.

An allowance of Rs. 5 per mensem termed Risk Allowance will be given to the staff in the Fire Brigade below the rank of Sub-Officers in consideration of the risk inherent in their duties. The Compensatory allowance now given will be discontinued.

#### 6. Uniform allowance to Excise staff.

The uniform allowance of Rs. 500 payable once in ten years to the Deputy and Assistant Commissioners will be discontinued.

The existing uniform allowance of Rs. 70 payable once in five years to the Excise Inspectors will be enhanced to Rs. 100.

## 7. Part-time Contingent Employees.

The basic wage and Dearness Allowance of the Part-time Contingent Employees will be revised as shown in Annexure V.

#### C. PATTERN OF SUPERVISORY POSTS.

The Supervisory posts in the various Departments will be brought into a common pattern as shown below:

Offices of Heads of Departments.	Rs.
Senior Superintendent	200-350
Junior Superintendent	150-250

Subordinate Offices.

Head Clerk and Head Accountant in offices where the number of clerks his 15 or more.

Head Clerk and Head Accountant in offices where the number of clerks is less than 15 but not less than 5.

Heads of Departments will forward proposals for fixing the number of Supervisory Posts in each Department together with office-wise statement showing the distribution of the supervisory posts and the number of clerks in the offices.

## D. DATE OF EFFECT.

The above orders will take effect from 1st April 1958. Excess if any drawn prior to issue of these orders need not however be refunded.

## E. OTHER RECOMMENDATIONS.

- 1. The Committee has recommended the grant of House Rent Allowance to the employees working in the Trivandrum City and the District Head-quarters at the following rates:—
  - (a) For those drawing a pay/salary of Rs. 100 and above upto and including Rs. 200 ... Rs. 7 per mensem
  - (b) For those drawing a pay/ salary below Rs. 100 ... Rs. 5 per mensem.

The Government find that the level of house rent in several places in the State is not lower than that at District Head-quarters and there is therefore no justification to grant such an

allowance only for those at District Head-quarters. The finances of the State do not however permit the grant of such an allowance throughout the State. Moreover all categories of employees will be getting an immediate benefit by the revision of scale and fixation of pay contemplated in these orders. Further, Government have decided to increase the existing rates of Special Dearness Allowance. Orders on this are being issued separately. In view of the above, the Government do not accept the recommendation of the Committee.

- 2. The Committee has also recommended that while fixing pay in the revised scale of pay, a senior officer's pay should be fixed at an amount not less than that of his junior. This recommendation has been considered by Government and found to be not acceptable.
- 3. The Committee has also made several other recommendations which require detailed examination. Orders on these recommendations will be issued separately.

## ANNEXURE II.

Rules for fixation of pay and grant of advance increments.

1. The pay of an officer in the revised scale of pay shall be fixed first at the stage in the new scale next above his present pay in the old scale, whether it is a stage in the new scale or not; if his present pay is less than the minimum of the new scale, his pay shall be fixed at the minimum.

Note.—The pay of an officer on 1-4-1958 including the increment, if any, accruing on that date shall be the present pay for the purpose of these rules. The word 'Pay' denotes 'salary' also.

2. In the case of Non-gazetted Officers, after pay is fixed under Rule (1) advance increments shall be granted in the new scale as specified below:

For a service of less than 10 years

.. Nil.

For a service of 10 years and more but less than 20 years One advance increment.

For a service of 20 years and more but less than 25 years Two advance increments.

For a service of 25 years and more

Three advance increments.

Note.—(i) The benefits of rules 1 and 2 will be given even in cases where the scale of pay of the post has not been revised, but which has been included in this scheme of revision shown as Annexure I.

- (ii) (a) 'Service' in the same class of posts irrespective of grades shall count for advance increments, e.g., a clerk will count his service as clerk and a Co-operative Inspector service as Co-operative Inspector.
  - (b) 'Service' means service qualifying for increments and includes service in a post or posts on fixed pay.
- 3. In cases in which the pay of an officer in a lower scale which he would have held but for his promotion to the higher scale happens to be equal to or higher than his pay in a higher scale, his pay in the higher scale shall be fixed at the stage next above his pay in the lower scale. Confirmation of an officer in the higher post shall not be a bar for getting this benefit.

- 4. If an officer is on leave on 1-4-1958 his pay in the new scale shall be fixed at the stage in the new scales to which he would be entitled if he had rejoined duty on such date. The benefit of the revised pay will, however, accrue only from the date on which the officer actually rejoins duty except in the case of an officer on privilege leave, earned leave, maternity leave, or long leave preparatory to retirement.
- 5. The pay of an officer under suspension as penalty on 1-4-58 and of an officer whose promotion/increments stand barred on 1-4-1958 will be fixed applying these rules but the benefit of the revised pay will be allowed only on his rejoining duty or the expiry of the period of bar, as the case may be.

- 6. An officer whose pay is revised under the present scheme will be allowed to exercise option to remain in the existing scale whether it be substantive or officiating until such time as he considers it necessary.
- 7. A period of two months from the date of this order is fixed for the exercise of this option. An officer on leave shall be allowed to exercise this option within a period of one month from the date of return from leave. The power of accepting the option of all officers cunder them is delegated to the Heads of Departments.
- 8. The option once exercised shall be final. If an officer does not exercise the option within the specified period it will be presumed that he has opted to have his pay fixed in the revised scale on 1-4-1958.
- 9. If an officer lopts to remain in the existing scale of pay for a specified period his pay on coming over to the revised scale will also be fixed in accordance with these rules.
- 10. Heads of Departments and offices will fix the pay of all Non-gazetted Officers in accordance with these rules. In the case of Gazetted Officers, the drawal of revised salary will be authorised by the Comptroller on the basis of the existing nominations.
  - 11. Arrear claims preferred in pursuance to these orders will be paid without preaudit in relaxation of Note 5 to the Article 100 Financial and Account Code.
