In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (a) of sub-section (2) of section 64 of Kerala Water Supply and Sewerage Act, 1986 (14 of 1986) and sub-section (3) of section 8 thereof, and in supersession of all existing rules and orders on this subject, the Government of Kerala hereby make the following Kerala Water Authority Technical Service Rules, namely:—



RULES

- 1. Short title and commencement.—(1) These rules may be called the Kerala Water Authority Technical Service Rules, 2023.
 - (2) They shall come into force at once.

Note:—The conversions proposed under rule 3 above shall come into effect as and when the existing incumbents vacate the post by retirement or otherwise. Re-designation of the existing vacancies will be with immediate effect.



- 4. Qualification regarding age.—No person shall be eligible for appointment by direct recruitment if he/she has not completed 18 years of age and if he/she has completed 36 years of age except for those posts wherein specific age limit is specified in the rule, subject to usual relaxation in the case of SC, ST and OBC candidates. In no case, the maximum age limit shall exceed 50 years for direct recruitment.
- 5. Reservation of appointment.—The rules regarding reservation of appointment ie, General Rules 14 to 17, Part II of the Kerala State and Subordinate Service Rules, 1958 as amended from time to time shall apply to the appointment by direct recruitment. The above rules shall not apply to direct recruitment from in-service personnel.
- 6. Direct Recruitment from Inservice Quota.—Shall be filled up by KPSC Recruitment. In no case, the maximum age limit shall exceed 50 years for in service recruitment.
- 7. Appointing Authority.—The appointing authority for all categories of posts mentioned in these rules shall be the Managing Director, Kerala Water Authority.
- 8. *Probation*.—Every person appointed to any of the categories of posts shall from the date of which he/she joins duty be on probation,
 - (i) if appointed by direct recruitment or by direct recruitment from qualified in-service personnel, for a total period of two years on duty within a continuous period of three years.
 - (ii) if appointed by promotion, for a period of one year on duty within a continuous period of two years.
- 9. *Departmental Tests*.—Every Person appointed to categories mentioned as Sl. No. 4 & 5 of Category I and Sl. No. 1, 2, 3, 4 of Category II shall within the prescribed period of probation pass the Account Test (Lower) and the PWD Tests.
- 10. Application of the Kerala State and Subordinate Services Rules and of the Kerala Civil Services (Classification, Control and Appeal) Rules to the employees of the Authority.—

11. Application of the Kerala Service Rules to the employees of the Authority.—The

provisions contained in Parts I, II and III of the Kerala Service Rules as amended from time to

time shall apply to the employees appointed under these rules in the matter of pay, fixation of

pay, joining time, travelling allowances and such other matters with respect to which the Kerala

Water Authority is not competent to make provisions under the Kerala Water Supply &

Sewerage Act, 1986 or rules made thereunder.

12. Protection of rights of employees appointed in the Public Health Engineering

Department.—The rights and benefits of the employees who had been appointed in the

erstwhile Public Health Engineering Department & KWA before the coming into force of these

Rules are prescribed in the KPHESS Special Rules, shall be protected in matters relating to

qualification and promotions. Wherever minimum in-service experience is specified in the rule

for promotions to higher posts, the service rendered in the erstwhile Public Health Engineering

Department shall also be taken into account. Similarly in the case of staff transferred from

Municipalities, the service in the Municipalities shall be deemed to be the service for the

purpose of these rules.

13. Eligibility for promotion & By Transfer.—Prescribed qualifications shall be attained

on or before the date of occurrence of vacancy.
