NOTIFICATION

G. O. (P) No. 216/2012/Fin. Dated, Thiruvananthapuram, 11th April, 2012.

S. R. O. No. 261/2012.—In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of Section 2 of the Kerala Public Services Act, 1968 (19 of 1968), read with section 3 thereof, the Government of Kerala hereby make the following rules, further to amend the Kerala Service Rules, namely:—

RULES

1. *Short title and commencement.*—(1) These rules may be called the Kerala Service (Second Amendment) Rules, 2012.

(2) clause (a) of sub-rule (1) and sub-rule (2) of rule 2 shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of April, 2009 and the remaining provisions shall be deemed to have come into force on 24th day of September, 2009.

2. *Amendment of the Rules.*—In part I of the Kerala Service Rules,—

- (1) (a) in rules 100, for the figures “135” the figures “180” shall be substituted;
- (b) in Note 5 to rule 100, for the figures “135” the figures “180” shall be substituted;
- (2) after rule 101, the following rule shall be inserted, namely:—
“101 A. Leave under rule 100 may also be granted to female officers in cases of hysterectomy subject to the condition that the leave does not exceed 45 days and application for the leave is supported by a certificate from the medical attendant.”

Explanatory Note

(This does not form part of the notification, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

As per G. O. (P) No. 129/09/Fin. dated the 1st April, 2009, Government have enhanced the number of days of Maternity Leave from 135 days to 180 days and allowed leave under rule 100, Part I, Kerala Service Rules to female officers in cases of hysterectomy for a period of 45 days on production of a certificate from the Medical Attendant. As per G. O. (P) No. 408/09/Fin. dated the 24th September, 2009, Government have enhanced the limit of 135 days in Note 5 to rule 100, Part I, Kerala Service Rules to 180 days to get the benefit to female recruits through Public Service Commission who join duty within 180 days from the date of delivery subject to conditions. In order to give statutory validity to the above order Government have decided to amend the said rules.

The notification is intended to achieve the above object.
