Director of Treasuries and SPARK PMU are hereby directed to make immediate necessary arrangements to facilitate the smooth transaction of online, digitally authenticated, paperless monthly salary bills of these departments from 01/2021 onwards and ensure that such claims are passed in Treasuries after due verification of the documents/bill received online.

Necessary codal amendments in this regard will be issued later.
