REVISION OF SCALES OF PAY AT CENTRAL RATES—AMENDMENTS TO THE ORDERS IN G. O. DATED 25-9-1993-

ORDER

- As per G. O. read as 1st paper above, scales of pay of State Government employees and teachers have been revised with effect from 1-3-1992. Some of the service associations of employees and teachers and also some individual employees represented that certain decisions taken as per the G. O. dated 25-9-1993 have adversome marvidual employees represented that certain accisions taken as per the G. O. dated 45-5-1555 have adversely affected them and hence requested to reconsider those issues. The Cabinet Sub-Committe, after discussion with various Service Associations and detailed study of the representations, made its recommendations in this regard. Based on these recommendations, Government are pleased to issue the following orders in modification of the orders already issued. Date of effect of these orders will be 1-3-1992 unless otherwise specified.
- 2. Annexure I to G. O. (P) 600/93/Fin. dated 25-9-1993 (schedule of scales of pay), referred to in para 4 ibid, is replaced by the Annexure I to this order. The revised scales of pay given therein are corresponding scales. These will take effect from 1-3-1992 itself. The revised scales of pay for various posts given in Annexure II to G. O. dated 25-9-1993 will be in force, subject to the modifications ordered below:
 - Scales of pay of posts under "General Education" will be as shown in Annexure II to this order.
- The posts having the following pre-revised scales will be assigned the new revised scales a hereunder:

(c) The revised scales of pay shown as S1. Nos. 12, 20 and 22 in Annexure I to G. O. dated 25-9-1993 are modified as follows for regulating increment rates uniform in comparison with immediate lower and higher and also to improve the maximum of the scale of pay.

- (d) The revised scale of pay of Rs. 1760-60-2600-75-3050 will be given to the post of Office Superintendent in the Secretariat, Kerala Public Service Commission, Advocate General's Office and Local Fund Audit Department whose pre-revised scale of pay is Rs. 1330-2555+Rs. 50 special pay Annexure II to G. O. dated 25-9-1993 stands modified to this extent.
 - (c) In Annexure II to the G. O. dated 25-9-1993 following addition/modifications are ordered:-

Promotion Prospects

- 3. Orders issued in paras 8, and 9 of G. O. read as 1st paper above are cancelled and the following revised orders are issued:
 - (a) Ratio/Percentage based higher grades:—
 All the existing ratio/percentage based higher grades will continue.
 - (b) Time Bound Higher Grade Promotion Scheme:
- 1. The existing time bound higher grade promotion scheme and the grades to be assigned on revision of pay scales under the scheme, will be modified as specified in the tables given below with effect from 1st March/1992. The general conditions for the grant of higher grades as laid down in Government Circular No. 54/92(138) Fin. dated 6-11-1992 will be followed, subject to the following specified/m diffied conditions:-
- 2. Employees who remain in their entry posts on scales of pay ranging from Rs. 775-1065 to Rs. 2500-4000 on completion of prescribed periods of service in these posts; will be granted higher grades as specified below:—
- (i) Those on entry posts with pay scales of Rs. 775-1065 to Rs. 1400-2300 will be granted three higher grades as follows with the scales of pay indicated in Table I.
 - (a) The first higher grade on completion of 10 years of service in the entry post.
 - (b) The second higher grade on completion of either 10 years of service in the first promoted post or a total service of 20 years in the entry post and the first regular promotion post/time bound higher grade together, whichever is earlier.
 - (c) The third higher grade on completion of 25 years of total service in the entry post and regular promotion post(s)/time bound higher grade (s) together.

(ii) Those on entry posts with pay scales ranging from Rs. 1400-2600 to Rs. 2375-3500 will be granted two time bound grades; the 1st on completion of 10 years of service in the entry post and the second on completion of either 10 years of service in the first promotion post or 20 years of total service in the entry post and 1st promotion post/higher grade together, whichever is earlier, as specified in Table II below:

- *This Table is not applicable in the case of Assistant Surgeons/Dental Surgeons of Health Departmen and Assistant Insurance Medical Officers of Insurance Medical Services. Their time bound grade are given separately in para 6.
- (iii) The second higher grade as mentioned under Table I and II above will be available to all those who may get their first promotion even in a shorter span than ten years by the operation of any of the existing norms for such promotion.
- (iv) Clerks and Accountants in all departments will be allowed higher grade on Rs. 1520-2660 (equivalent to the scale of pay of Junior Superintendent) on completion of total service of 25 years as at present. The existing benefit of higher grade in the scale of pay of Junior Superintendent allowed to L.D. Clerks in Aided Schools on completion of total service of 23 years will also continue. Similarly, Last Grade Employees in Aided Schools will be allowed the scale of pay of Rs. 950-1500 on completion of 23 years of service as at present.
- (v) In the case of professional colleges (where U.G.C./AICTE pattern of scales are not applicable) where there exist four levels from the entry grade to the Professor's grade, a total period of 10 years of service in the first two levels will qualify for the 1st higher grade specified in Table II above.
- (vi) For direct recruits against posts carrying the scale of Rs. 2500-4000, one higher grade promotion in the scale of pay of Rs. 2650-4200 will be given on completion of ten years of service. However, a direct recruit will get the benefit of 10 year time bound promotion only if his non-direct recruit senior has been promoted. For incumbents of posts on scales of pay above Rs. 2500-4000, no time bound higher grade will be allowed.
- (vii) If there is a promotion post in respect of the categories of posts (entry) coming under pay range from Rs. 775-1065 to 1640-2900 and its scale of pay is higher than the time bound grade proposed above, then the qualified incumbent will be given the scale of pay of the promotion post in the direct line of promotion as time bound higher grade. While assigning higher grades, only qualified hands i.e. those possessing the qualifications prescribed for the promotion post, will get the scales of pay of regular promotion posts. Unqualified hands will be allowed the next higher scale of pay above that of the scale of pay of the post held at that time, in the standard scales of pay.

If the scale of pay of the promotion post is lower than the time-bound higher grade proposed, the total service in both the lower posts will be taken together for the time-bound higher grade specified above. In such cases the fixation under Rule 28-A Part I, KSR for the 10 year grade will be based on the basic pay of the lowest post.

- (viii) In the case of entry posts whose scales of pay are Rs. 2000-3200 and above, time bound higher grade scales will be as specified in the table given above. Scales of pay of promotion posts will not be given as time bound higher grade in these cases.
- (ix) The persons enjoying time-bound higher grades in various posts in accordance with the prerevision partern will be given only the specified grades of pay indicated in the Tables above and not the corresponding scales of their present time bound grades unless ordered otherwise.

Qualifying Service and Determination of Grades

- (i) The term 'entry post' shall be defined as the post to which an employee is initially appointed in Government service by direct recruitment by the competent authority. Appointments by transfer will also be treated as equivalent to direct recruitment for allowing the benefit of higher grade. The time bound grade/grades admissible will be determined with reference to this initial entry post only. Those who get regular promotion or appointment to higher posts within the period specified for each time bound higher grade, will not be granted further time bound higher grade during that period.
- (ii) Scales of pay in column 1 of the tables above denotes the pay scales of the posts to which the employees are recruited initially and the time-bound higher grades allowable on completion of prescribes periods of service on each such entry post, will be as specified in column 2, 3 and 4 of the tables as the case may be and not with reference to the scale of pay of the promotion post or higher post held subsequently.
- (iii) In case the scale of pay of the regular promotion post is higher than the time-bound higher grade allowed as specified in the tables above, fixation of pay on his promotion to this regular post will be done based on the basic pay notionally arrived at in the lower post.
- (iv) In case the 20/25 year higher grades as per the tables above are equal to or lower than the 1st promotion post/second-promotion post as the case may be, that grade(s) will be modified and fixed at the next higher scale(s) above that of the promotion post(s) in the list of standard scales of pay.
- (v) Those who are eligible for the higher grade on completion of the specified qualifying service shall be given the right of option to elect any date for that higher grade. The option shall be exercised within three months from the date on which the higher grade fell due, failing which the higher grade will be granted with effect from the date itfell due.
- (vi) War/military service which counts for civil pension will be reckoned for computing the qualifying service for the grant of first higher grade. Civilian service under military will not, however, count for higher grade.
- Attenders/Clerical Assistants, Binders and Drivers appointed by transfer from last grade service (vii) are eligible for reckoning their last grade service also for computing the total qualifying service for the 25 years grade in the cadre of Attenders/Clerical Assistants, Binders and Drivers. The benefit is not admissible for the 10 and 20 years time bound grades in the above posts.
- (viii) Non-teaching staff of Aided-Schools, Private Colleges and Polytechnics who come under the scheme of direct payment of salary by Government are also eligible for time bound grade promotion subjec to the modifications referred to above.
- (ix) Employees having higher time bound grades as on 1-3-1992 or date of option, as the case may be, will be fitted into the new time bound grades as noted above; but time bound grades under the prerevision scheme will not be allowed on or after 1-3-1992.
- (x) In case the pay fixed in the new time bound grades following the methods specified above is less than the pay drawn in the pre-revised grade, the difference will be protected as 'personal pay' to be absorbed at the time of next promotion/grade.
- . (xi) Time bound grades fell due on or after 1-3-1992 and already granted under the existing scheme will be reviewed and revised time bound grades as mentioned in the tables above will be allowed, based on the above rules.
- (xii) Those who relinquished or relinquish regular promotions will not be given time bound higher grades, as at present.

Teachers

- 5. (a) Orders issued in paras 10 and 11 of G.O. (P) 600/93/Fin. dated 25-9-1993 are hereby cancelled instead, Government are pleased to order that the time bound grade promotion schemes existed earlier which was applicable to feachers and Headmasters of primary and secondary schools will continue as such. All the ruls/guidlinese which were followed for the above purpose will be continued. Similarly, Headmasters of Primary and Schools will be continued. of Primary Schools and Henmasters of Secondary Schools will be eligible for their higher grades on the basis of the same rules/guidelines which were being followed earlier.
- (b) Revised scales of pay of all the categories of posts coming under the General Education Department' are also modified as shown in Annexure II to this order. The schedule coming under the heading "II General Education" (up to and including the sub heading "District Institute of Education and Training") (vide pages 19-25 of G. O. dated 25-9-1993) stands modified to the above extent.

6. Assistant Surgeon/Dental Surgeon and equated categories of Health Services Department and the Assistant Insurance Medical Officers of Insurance Medical Services Department will be given the scales of pay of Rs. 2500-4000 and Rs. 3000-5000 as their 12 years and 24 years time-bound higher grade scales respectively.

The rules for fixation will be:-

- (i) Those having 10 years higher grade but not completed 12 years of service on the date of option of the revised scale will be straight way fitted in the basic scale of the post as revised, on the basis of the pay they would have drawn on the date of option in the entry post following the pay fixation rules given in Annexure III of G. O. dated 25-9-1993.
- (ii) Those having 12 years of service or more with 10 years grade will be fitted in the new 12 years time-bound grade following the fixation rules in Annexure III to the G.O dated 25-9-1993. On completion of 24 years of qualifying service, they will be given the new 24 years grade with fixation of pay under Rule 28A Part I, KSR.
- (iii) Those having 20 years higher grade but not completed 24 years of service on the date of option of the revised scale will be fitted in the new 12 year higher grade following the fixation in Annexure III. On completion of 24 years of service they will be assigned the new 24 years grade and their pay fixed following the principles in Government Decision below Rule-30, Part I, KSR, since they have already enjoyed Rule 28A benefit in the pre-revision second higher grade.
- (iv) Those who have completed 24 years of service as on 1-3-1992 or date of option will be fitted in the 24 years grade following the fixation rules in Annexire III.

Rules for Fixation

- 7. Following modifications are made to Annexure III of G. O. (P) 600/93/Fin. dated 25-9-1993, containing the rules for fixation of pay and referred to in para 6 of the G. O.
 - (i) In the said Annexure III under para 4 (a), the following will be added:

 "However, if an employee wishes to opt the revised scale of pay of his promoted post to which he was promoted on or after 1-3-1992 he will be permitted to opt the revised scale of the promoted post with effect from the date of promotion and his pay in the revised scale fixed on the basis of the pay he drew in the pre-revision scale of the promoted post on that date. The restriction that option will be limited to one post will be applicable to those also."
 - (ii) In the above Annexure III under third sub para of para 8 (a), the following will be added:—
 "However, this will not be applicable in the case of those who exercise option in the promoted post on the date of promotion on or after 1-3-1992—vide amended para 4 (a) of the rules for Fixation of Pay".

Payment of Revised Salary

- 8. (a) In partial modification of the orders issued in para 7 of G.O. (P) 600/93/Fin. dated 25-9-1993, Government order that arrears of salary on fixation of pay in the revised pay scales for the period upto 31-8-1993 to be impounded and credited to P. F. account will not be allowed to be withdrawn till 30-9-1995. However, in the case of P. T. Contingent employees, the arrears will be paid in cash. Para 7 of G.O. dated 25-9-1993 stands modified to the extent.
- (b) Arrears (both to be credited to PF and that to be encashed) should be claimed as part of salary bill for any month upto June 1994. 'NIL' bills for crediting arrear to G.P.F. should be avoided. For claiming the salary for July 1994, a certificate should be attached to the salary bill to the effect that the arrears of salary for the period from 1-3-1992 to 31-8-1993 have been claimed and credited to P. F. account of the employee.

Increments

9. Para 13(a) of G. O. (P) 600/93/Fin. dated 25-9-1993 is substituted by the following:

Rates.—Increment rates in the revised scales of pay are comparatively less than those in the existing state scales of pay. In order to protect the drop in the increment rates on fixation of pay in the revised scale the following procedure will be followed:

If the increment drawn in the pre-revision scale is higher than the increment due in the revised scale, the difference will be protected by way of 'Personal Pay' at each incremental stage in the revised scale. Such personal pay will continue till the rate of increment in the revised scale becomes the same or more than that 4/314/95—2.

drawn in the pre-revision scale on earning increment in the revised scale or on promotion or on revision of scales of pay. On promotion/revision of scales of pay, this personal pay will be merged with basic pay and the pay in the promoted scale fixed on the basis of it. In cases where there is difference between the increment rate drawn in the pre-revision scale and the rate in the promoted post, that difference will be protected as personal pay. The personal pay will also be taken into account for calculating D.A., H.R.A. and C.C.A. rates.

An illustration is given below:-

An Upper Division Clerk drawing a pay of Rs. 1290 from 1-7-1991 in the scale of Rs. 950-25-1100-30-1250-40-1530-60-1590, enjoying the rate of increment of Rs. 40, on revision of scale to Rs. 1200-30-1560-40-2040, with effect from 1-3-1992 will get his pay fixed at Rs. 1410. The rate of increment in his revised scale would be only Rs. 30 on 1-7-1992 and it will be the same till he reached the stage of Rs. 1560 in the scale. Hence the difference of Rs. 10 in the incremental rate will he protected at each incremental stage in the revised scale, till the increment rate in the revised scale also become Rs. 40 or more as follows:

Stagnation Increments

10. Para 13 (b) of G.O. (P) 600/93/Fin. dated 25-9-1993 is substituted as follows:—
"Employees who reach the maximum of their scales of pay and become ineligible for any increment in their existing scales are now granted three stagnation increments—the first two annual and the last one biennial after reaching the maximum of the scale. This scheme will continue".

Leave and Surrender of Earned Leave

11. Para number 17 appearing in page viii of Government order dated 25-9-1993 should be read as 16.

Under sub para (iv) of the above para the following will be added:

"Recovery of such amount will be limited to 50% of the arrears of salary payable for the period upto 31-8-1993 and the quantum of Earned Leave corresponding to the amount so recovered will be credited back to the leave account of the employee. In cases where no arrear amount is available for recovery, credit back of Earned Leave will not be allowed".

- Note:—1. For reckoning the admissible quantum of Earned Leave during the year 1991-92 on the basis of the revised orders dated 25-9-1993, the days of Earned Leave surrendered in excess of 15 days during 3/92 alone will be taken into account.
 - 2. For reckoning the days of Earned Leave to be credited to the employees leave account corresponding to the amount of recovery made, fractions less than 0.5 day will be omitted and fractions above 0.5 day will be rounded to the full day.

General

- 12. The Government are pleased to issue the following further orders:
- (a) The Accountant General will authorise the drawal of revised salary only in the case of Gazetted Officers whose scale of pay is Rs. 2000-3200 and above, on the basis of their option, following the existing practice.
- (b) Special pay of Rs. 100 and Rs. 50 sanctioned to Executive Officer Grade I and Executive Officer Grade II respectively of the Panchayat Department in the Government Order dated 25-9-1993 is not in lieu of higher time scale.
- (c) In Appendix II referred to in para 3 (iii) of Annexure III to Government Order dated 25-9-1993 the following modifications are made:
 - (i) Six more new tables (given as Appendix I to this order) incorporated.
 - (ii) Table Nos. 6, 7, 8, 16, 20, 21, 26, 28, 29, 32, 33 and 35 cancelled.
- (d) In the case of posts created/upgraded in the pre-revision scales of pay on or after 1-3-1992, they will be assigned the corresponding revised scales of pay as given in Annexure I to this order.
- (c) Amendments, if any, required in respect of rules/guidelines issued in G.O read as 1st paper above and these orders, including revision of scales of pass, grades, ratios etc. will be ordered only by the Finance (PRC) Department. Proposals in this regard should be sent by the Heads of Department through the Administrative Department of the Secretariat.
- (f) Options, if any, already exercised on the basis of the Government Order read as 1st paper above can be withdrawn and revised option submitted, if found necessary, on the basis of these orders.

Erratum

13. Some printing mistakes are noticed in the Government order read as 1st paper above. Those have been rectified as shown in Appendix II to this order.
