Sub:—Admissibility of joining time on request transfer after completing one year duty at the outstation—Further instructions issued.

Ref:—G.O. (P) 480/89/Fin. dated 1-11-1989.

As per para 46 (d) of the G.O. cited, Travelling Allowance will be paid in cases of "on request" transfers provided the official concerned has spent at least one full year (excluding periods of leave) at the station from which he seeks transfer. A doubt has been raised whether in such cases joining time admissible under Rule 127 Part I Kerala Service Rules can be granted. It is hereby clarified that in such cases no joining time will be admissible. But actual journey time can be allowed.
